Heavy snow fall over the last 4 days has brought between 4 and 7 feet of powder to the Tahoe basin!

Squaw Valley-OPEN

Winter is here with over 5 feet of snow in the last 72 hours!

Heavenly-OPEN

Up to 3 feet of snow fell on Heavenly in the last 72 hours!

Mt.Rose-OPEN

Four feet of white, fluffy powder has descended upon Mt. Rose over the last 4 days. The Slide Bowl will open Jan. 24th with parking and ticket services. The Blazing Zephyr high-speed 6-pack will start turning on Jan. 24th as well.

Mt. Rose Ski Tahoe is open from top to bottom for the 2011-12 season! Most lifts are open with miles of groomed terrain for every level of skier.

Diamond Peak-OPEN

Three and a half feet of powder over the last 72 hours!

Diamond Peak is open from top to bottom! All but two lifts are running with miles of groomed terrain and trails.

Alpine Meadows - OPEN

Alpine Meadows has received over 6 feet of snow in the last 72 hours and it's still snowing!
